Professional Appearance

Maintain good lighting for virtual interviews

The STAR Method

One of the most effective ways to answer behavioral interview questions is the STAR Method.

S – Situation

Describe the background.

T – Task

Explain your responsibility.

A – Action

Describe what you did.

R – Result

Share the outcome and what you learned.

Example

Question:

Tell me about a time you resolved a difficult customer issue.

Situation

A provider contacted our department regarding multiple denied claims.

Task

I was responsible for investigating the denials and resolving the issue.

Action

I reviewed the claim history, contacted the payer, identified an eligibility error, coordinated corrections, and educated the provider on preventing future denials.

Result

The claims were successfully reprocessed, payment was issued, and provider satisfaction improved.

Common Interview Questions

Tell me about yourself.

Why are you interested in this position?

Why are you leaving your current employer?

Describe a difficult situation.

Tell me about a time you improved a process.

Describe a leadership experience.

Tell me about a mistake you learned from.

Where do you see yourself in five years?

Why should we hire you?

Questions You Should Ask

Ask questions like:

What does success look like during the first 90 days?

What challenges is the team currently facing?

What qualities do your highest-performing employees share?

How would you describe your company culture?

What opportunities exist for professional development?

What are the next steps in the hiring process?
